God's People Confess Their Faith:

We believe that from all eternity God determined in grace to save a great multitude of guilty sinners from every tribe and language and people and nation, and to this end foreknew them and chose them. We believe that God justifies and sanctifies those who by grace have faith in Jesus, and that He will one day glorify them—all to the praise of His glorious grace. In love God commands and implores all people to repent and believe, having set His saving love on those He has chosen and having ordained Christ to be their Redeemer.

God Calls His People to Repentance

If a man does not repent, God will whet His sword; He has bent and readied His bow; He has prepared for Him His deadly weapons, making His arrows fiery shafts. (Psalm 7:12–13)

God's People Confess Their Sin

Have mercy on us, O God, according to Your steadfast love; according to Your abundant mercy blot out our transgressions. Wash us thoroughly from our iniquities, and cleanse us from our sins. For we know our transgressions, and our sin is ever before us. Against You, You alone, have we sinned, and done what is evil in Your sight, so that You are justified in Your sentence and blameless when You pass judgment. Indeed, we were born guilty sinners when our mothers conceived us. Hide Your face from our sins, and blot

out all our iniquities. Create in us clean hearts, O God, and put new and right spirits within us. Do not cast us away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from us, we pray through Him Who loved us and gave Himself for us, even our Lord Jesus Christ.
