The Confession of Faith: Westminster Larger Catechism No. 70

Q: What is justification?

A: Justification is an act of God's free grace unto sinners, in which he pardons all their sins, accepts and accounts their persons righteous in his sight; not for anything worked in them, or done by them, but only for the perfect obedience and full satisfaction of Christ, by God credited to them, and received by faith alone.

God Calls Us to Repentance

Your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear. (Isaiah 59:2)

God's People Confess Their Sin

Almighty and Holy God Who is enthroned above the cherubim. We confess our sinfulness to You with sorrow and shame. We have not obeyed You as we ought to obey our Creator; we have not loved You as we ought to love our Sustainer; we have not delighted in You as we ought to delight in our Redeemer. We confess our desires are not only for things wholly pleasing in Your sight, and we have sinned against You and our neighbor in thought, word, and deed. Please forgive us. Please hear us! Please take away our shame. We praise You for the Lord Jesus Christ who has opened up a new and living way through His flesh so that You will not forsake Your own, but will pardon and cleanse us, because of Your covenant faithfulness.

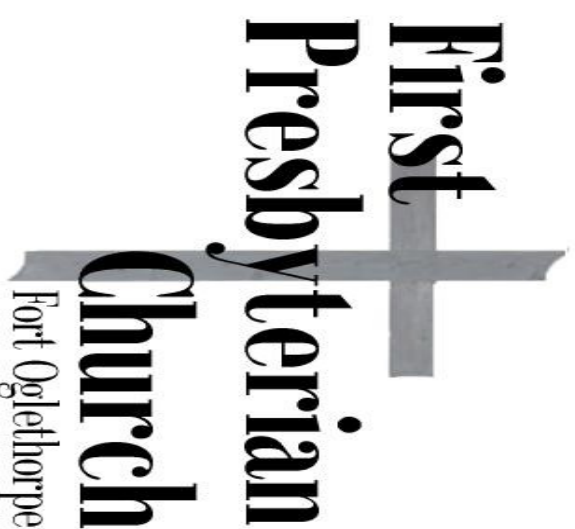
