We have been cold in our love to You, weak in our desires toward You, unsteady in our walking with You, and are even at this time poorly prepared to serve You. We beseech You: Forgive us all our sins, for Christ's sake, and be at peace with us in Him Who

died to make peace and lives to make intercession for us. Amen.


