The Confession of Faith: Scots Confession of Faith (1560) No. 4
For this we constantly believe: after the fearful and horrible defec-
tion of man from his obedience, God did seek Adam again,
call upon him, rebuke his sin, convict him of his sin, and in the
end made unto him a most joyful promise: that the seed of the
woman would break down the serpent's head that is, He would
destroy the works of the Devil. Which promise, as it was re-
peated and made more clear from time to time, so was it em-
braced with joy, and most constantly received of all the faithful,
from Adam to Noah, from Noah to Abraham, from Abraham to
David, and so forth to the incarnation of Christ Jesus.

God Calls Us to Repentance: Exodus 20:4-6

I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of
Egypt, out of the house of slavery... You shall not make for
yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in
heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the
water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or
serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting
the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the
fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast
love to thousands of those who love me and keep my
commandments.

God's People Confess Their Sin

Our Father in Heaven, we have no right to call you *Father*
because we have sinned against you; we ought to come before
you as guilty, condemned sinners to a judge about to pass - and
execute - sentence. But we come through Christ our only
Mediator to you our Father confessing our sin with shame and
sorrow, for we have not kept Your commandments. We have
not kept pure all the religious worship you have appointed in
Your word; we have not been zealous for your worship as you
are zealous for it. We have neglected to live in light of Your
sovereignty as the great King above all gods. Instead of

allowing Your word to dwell richly in us, we have allowed
created things - traditions, symbols, and superstitions - to
have spiritual power over us and value for us. Forgive us
about how passionate we can be about our own traditions and
how disinterested we are to seek You as You command us in
your word. Show us mercy in Christ, take away our shame and
cover us with Your love anew that we may delight to worship
you in Spirit and Truth in accordance with Your holy and
word revealed will.
