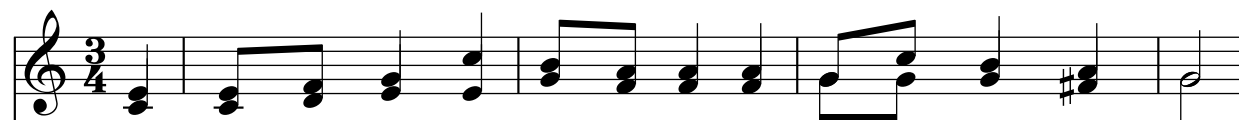

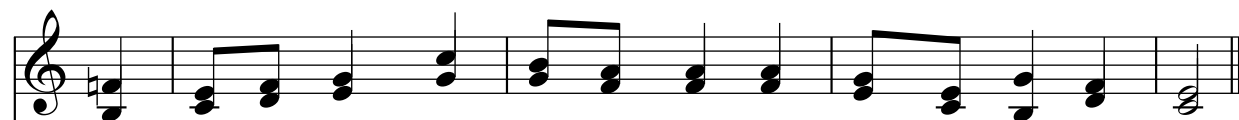
*THE RESPONSEPsalm 72:18-19
