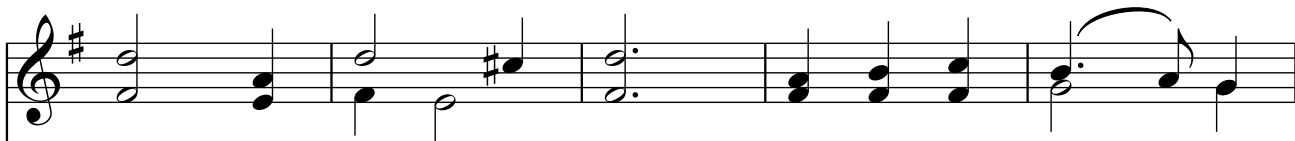
THE ASSURANCE OF PARDON.....Romans 8:15-17
