Second, so that we may never stop striving and never stop praying to God for the grace of the Holy Spirit, so that we may be renewed more and more after God's image, until after this life we reach our goal: perfection.




All Praise to God, Who Reigns Above


- 6. ⁷Let sea and land and all they hold resound with one accord. (sing two times)


